Water Base Metallic

#1. Basecoat: A. Santa face, clown face, bag and drum strap with Toffee, B. Robe & gown Barn Red. C. Fur, clown ruffles, piano keys-White. D. Gloves & Drum heads-Bone. E. Teddy bear, toy top-Cocoa Brown. F. Tree & bag strap-Forest Green. G. Wagon-Medium Yellow. H. Clown hair-Pumpkin, I. Clown suit-Fuchsia, J. Drum-Intense Blue. K. Beard & eyebrows-Barely Grey. L. Piano, clown shoes & Santa boots-Black. #2. Antique entire piece Shimmering Bark. #3. Drybrush Santa face, bag & teddy bear with Toffee. Highlight with White. Blush cheeks & nose with Dusty Rose. #4. Drybrush robe & gown Barn Red; highlight Barely Grey. #5. Drybrush fur, beard, gloves & wagon White; heavier with White on beard & fur. #6. Drybrush tree & bag strap Forest Green; highlight Barely Grey. #7. Paint Dusty Rose on Santa's lip, teddy bear's bow, paw pads, & inside of ears. #8. Paint Metallic Gold on buckle, end of belt, bell, wagon wheels, drum rims & tassles on bell under drum. #9 Basecoat eyes on Santa & bear White. Santa's irises are Cocoa Brown with Black pupils. Bear's eyes are Country Blue with Black pupils, nose & mouth line. #10. Clown's eyes are closed. Make lash line Black. His nose is Barn Red.

Miscellaneous Silver Glitter Spray

Materials Needed:

Opaque Stains #900 White

#901 Bone

#902 Black

#915 Light Pink

#926 Country Blue

#1. Basecoat deer with equal mix of Bone & White. #Paint inside of legs, ears, hooves, antlers and outside of tail with equal mix of Country Blue & White. #3. Antique deer with Winter Blue antique. #4. Drybrush all pieces with Bone/White mix; then with White. #5. Dot inside of legs, ears & outside of tail with White. #6. Basecoat eyes White. Irises are Country Blue; pupils are Black with a White highlight. Paint nose & mouth line Black. #7. Blush cheeks Light Pink. #8. Spray antlers & hooves with Silver Glitter Spray.

#914 Dusty Rose

#934 Just Peachy

#917 Pumpkin

Basecoat deer Just Peachy. Drybrush with a mix of two parts White & one part Just Peachy. Highlight with White, heavier on muzzle & around eyes. Blush with Dusty Rose. #4. Paint inside of legs, inside of ears, hooves, antlers & outside of tail with Just Peachy. Drybrush lightly with White/Just Peachy mix. #5. Dot inside of legs, ears & outside of tail with White, #6. Basecoat eyes White, Irises are Fawn with a Pumpkin slash. Pupils & nose are Black.

Materials Needed: Opaque Stains

#902 Black -908 Tawny Beige #912 Wine

Oil Base Antique #1003 Shimmering Teak

#914 Dusty Rose

#1. Basecoat with Tawny Beige, #2. Antique with Shimmering Teak. #3. Drybrush body with Tawny Beige, highlight with White. Drybrush White Heavier on muzzle & around eyes. Blush cheeks with Dusty Rose. #4. Paint inside of legs, ears, hooves & antlers with Wine. #5. Drybrush Wine areas with two coats Raspberry Sherbet; highlight with Dusty Rose. #6. Dot inside of ears & legs with White. #7. Basecoat eyes White. Irises are Country Blue with Black pupils. #8. Paint nose & mouth line Black.

STABLE- #1. Basecoat stucco White. #Basecoat beams Rich Brown. #3. Basecoat stable Cocoa Brown, #4. Paint doors & ramp Barn Red. #5. Basecoat trees, holly on doors & post ridges Forest Green, #6. Antique with Shimmering Bark. #7. Drybrush stucco areas White. #8. Drybrush beams with Rich Brown, then

lightly with Cocoa Brown, #9, Drybrush stable with Cocoa Brown, then Toffee. Drybrush all wood lightly with White. #10. Drybrush doors with Barn Red. Lighten Barn Red with White & highlight. #11. Drybrush trees, holly on doors & post ridges with Forest Green. Lighten Forest Green with White and highlight. #12. Paint roof White. Stipple White on snow areas of trees. #13. Hinges & door handles are painted Metallic Gold. #14. Paint handle pitchfork Black. Tines are painted Metallic Silver, #15. Sparkle "snow" with Diamond Dust or brush on glitter.

BASE- #1. Basecoat Rich Brown. #2. Drybrush rock wall Smoke; then lightly with Barely Grey. Drybrush Toffee in random pattern. #3. Drybrush Barn Red on steps. Lighten Barn Red with white. Highlight steps. Stipple steps randomly with White. #4. Drybrush pebbles with Toffee. Drybrush on White in random pattern; do the same with Smoke & Forest Green. #5. Drybrush snow areas heavily with White. #6. Paint rim with Barn Red. Lighten Barn Red with White & highlight. #7. Apply Diamond Dust to snow.

ELVES & SANTA. #1. Basecoat all skin & beards Toffee. #2. Paint Santa's fur White. #3. Antique with Shimmering Bark. #4. Drybrush faces Toffee, highlight with White. Blush cheeks & noses with Dusty Rose. #5. Drybrush beards & fur with White. #6. Santa's suit is Barn Red. Gloves are Forest Green. Drybrush lightly with Barely Grey. Paint belt & boots with Black. #7. Clothes on elves are Barn Red & Forest Green. See picture for placement. Drybrush lightly with Barely Grey. Elf pants are Toffee. Design on clothes is White. #8. Basecoat eyes White. Irises are Country Blue; pupils are Black. #9. Buckles & quill are Metallic Gold. Whistle & clipboard are Silver.

REINDEER & MICE- #1. Basecoat with Toffee. #2. Antique with Shimmering Bark. #3. Drybrush with Toffee, then Warm Beige. Highlight with White-heavier on muzzle & around eyes. On deer drybrush White on chest & on outside of tail. Blush cheeks & inside of ears with Dusty Rose. #4. Basecoat eyes White. Irises are Cocoa Brown with Pumpkin slash. Pupils are Black. #5. Paint hooves, noses & mouthlines Black.

SIGN, HAY, FENCE- #1. Basecoat fence Cocoa Brown. #2. Basecoat hay Toffee. #Basecoat wood of sign Barn Red. Paint sign face White. #4. Antique all pieces Shimmering Bark. #5. Drybrush fence Cocoa Brown; then Toffee. Paint White on top of post for snow. #6. Drybrush hay with Caramel, then Medium Yellow. Highlight with White. #7. Drybrush wood areas of sign with Barn Red. Lighten Barn Red with White & drybrush again. #8. Apply Diamond Dust to snow areas.
