#900 White

#902 Black

#915 Light Pink

Oil Base Antique #1003 Shimmering Teak

Miscellaneous #Mineral Spirits

#1. Basecoat White. #2. Paint bills Light Pink. #3. Antique with Shimmering Teak. With a soft cloth, work the antique into the basecoat. Wipe down with Mineral Spirits or an antique solvent. #4. Paint eyes and nostrils Black.

DUCK- #1. Basecoat ducks White. #2. Antique with Shimmering Teak. #3. Drybrush White. Blush cheeks Light Pink. #4. Paint bills & feet Light Terra. #5. Paint eyes & nostrils Black. #6. Basecoat window Forest Green: work White into brush & highlight.

BLUEBIRDS- #1. Basecoat birds with Blueberry. #2. Drybrush heavily with Medium Blue. Highlight wings, around eyes & top knot with White. #3. Blush chest Dustry Rose. #4. Paint bills Medium Yellow. #5. Paint eye area White. Pupils are Black. #6. With a pencil draw in curtains. Paint in curtains White. Paint remaining area Barely Grey. #7. Paint window frame & box Raspberry Light. #8. Antique Shimmering Teak. #9. Drybrush frame & box with Raspberry Light. Highlight with White. #10. Paint tiebacks on curtains Country Blue. #11. Put small dots in a scallop pattern on edges of curtains with White.

CAT- #1. Basecoat cats Black. #2. Paint on ribbon & bow with Scarlet Red. #3. Draw a line about two-thirds down the window. Paint below the line with Barely Grey. Paint above the line White. Put small White dots in a scallop pattern along line. #4. Stipple on wreath with Forest Green. #5. Paint on bow with Scarlet Red. #6. Basecoat window frame & box Scarlet Red. #7. Antique whole window Shimmering Bark. #8. Drybrush frame lightly with White. #9. Apply White to edges of box to simulate snow.

RABBITS- #1. Basecoat rabbits Toffee. #2. Drybrush with Warm Beige. Highlight with White, heavier on tail & muzzle, #3. Blush cheeks & inside of ears Dusty Rose. #4. Paint eye White. Irises, noses & mouth lines are Black, #5. Paint window Country Blue. #7. Drybrush with Country Blue; highlight with Barely Grey.

DEER- #1. Basecoat deer Just Peachy. #2. Drybrush deer with a mixture of two parts White & one part Just Peachy. Highlight with White; heavier on the muzzle & around eves. Blush with Dusty Rose. #3. Paint inside of legs, ears, hooves, antlers, & outside of tail with Just Peachy. Drybrush lightly with the White/Just Peachy mix. #4. Dot inside of legs, tail & ears with White. #5. Basecoat eyes White. Irises are Fawn with a Pumpkin slash. Pupils & noses are Black.

SLEIGH- #1. Basecoat sleigh with Just Peachy. Drybrush a mixture of two parts White & one part Just Peachy. Highlight with White. #2. Paint rolled edge of sleigh with Just Peachy. Drybrush lightly with White. Dot these areas with White.

PACKAGES- #1. Basecoat with Just Peachy. Paint ribbon with a mix of two parts White & one part Just Peachy. Drybrush ribbons lightly with White. Dot packages with White.

ALL BONNET GIRLS- #1. Paint hat. sleeve and apron Bone. #2. Paint skirt & bodice Country Blue. #3. Paint hands & face Gentle Flesh. #4. With Fawn, outline outer edges hat, face, hand & sleeve. The line about 1/8 of an inch wide. Do not outline back edge & hem of apron. #5. Paint edges, back of girl, base & post with Fawn. #6. To antique the front: Antique with Shimmering Bark; wipe down with Mineral Spirits. #7. Dot top of hat with Country Blue. Design on Bone areas are done in Country Blue. Design on Country Blue areas are done in White. See picture for placement. #8. To antique base, post, back & sides: Antique with Shimmering Walnut. Wipe down with a dry cloth from top to bottom. It should be "streaky", giving it a "wood" look.

DUCKS- #1. Basecoat ducks Bone. #2. Antique with Shimmering Bark: wipe down with Mineral Spirits. #3. Drybrush ducks White. Blush cheeks Light Pink. #4. Paint bills & feet Light Terra. Drybrush lightly with White. #5. Paint eyes White. Irises & nostrils are Black. #6. Paint edges of ducks Fawn. #7. Antique edges Shimmering Walnut. Wipe down edges with a dry cloth. It should be "streaky" giving it a "wood" look.

NAPKIN HOLDER BASE-#1. Basecoat with Country Blue. #2. Antique with Shimmering Bark. Wipe down with Mineral Spirits. #3. Drybrush with Country Blue; highlight with White.
