Antiquing Solvent. #3. Drybrush face & hands with Dusty
Rose. #4. Drybrush hair White. #5. Paint eyes White. Irises are
Medium Blue. Pupils & outline are Black. #6. Paint hat Black.
Star & rim are Metallic Gold. Dot Intense Blue in star center,
Put a line of Metallic Gold descending dots on either side of
star. #7. Paint rifle Rich Brown; drybrush Cocoa Brown. #8.
Flow Metallic Gold on coat buttons & shoulder ridges. Paint
two White lines between Gold buttons on his chest. Dot
Intense Blue at end of White lines. #9. On cuffs, paint a White
line near lower edge. Paint on Metallic Gold lines going up cuff.
Place a White dot at lower end of each Gold line. BOX: #1.
Basecoat woodgrain area Forest Green. #2. Antique with
Shimmering Bark. Don't use solvent. #3. Drybrush woodgrain
Forest Green; highlight with Clover Green. #4. Paint box edges
Scarlet Red. #5. Paint ribbons on box White. #6. Letters are
painted Metallic Gold. #7. Apply two coats of Glossy Sealer to
soldier's hat, coat, gun & on Scarlet Red area of box.

Blush cheeks, nose & lips with Dusty Rose. #4. Wetbrush suit & hat Scarlet Red; work alltitle White into brush & highlight. #5. Wetbrush hair & fur White – heavier on fur. #6. Paint mittens Black; highlight Smoke. V stitches on mittens are White. #7. Paint eyes White. In:ses are Medium Blue. Pupils are Black with White dot. SLEIGH: #1. Basecoat A. Deer-Toffee; B. Antlers & teddy bear-Cocoa Brown; C. Snow & packages-White; D. Sleigh rim-Scarlet Red; E. Sleigh body-Forest Green. #2. Antique with Shimmering Bark. Wipe down with Antiquing Solvent on White areas only. #3. Wetbrush deer Toffee; highlight with Warm Beige; accent White around ears, eyes & mouth. #4. Wetbrush packages & snow White. #5. Drybrush teddy bear & antlers with Cocoa Brown; highlight with Toffee. Blush inside of teddy's ears with Dusty Rose. #6. Wetbrush sleigh rim Scarlet Red; work a little White into brush & highlight. #7. Wetbrush body of sleigh Forest Green; highlight with Clover Green. #8. Flow Metallic Gold on sleigh runners. #9. Paint deer eyes White. Irises are Cocoa Brown with a Pumpkin slash. Pupils, eyebrows, hooves & mouthlines are Black. #10. Paint deer's nose & bow Scarlet Red. Dot with White. #11. Large pkg. & left. pkg. is a dotted Scarlet Red with Forest Green into Dot with White. #11. Large pkg. & left. pkg. is dotted Scarlet Red with Forest Green into Dot with White. #11. Paint sleigh rim has Metallic Gold sweepies on curls. #14. Paint sleigh seats Burnt Brown; drybrush lightly with Toffee. #15. Apply Diamond Dust to snow areas.

Wetbrush deer Toffee; highlight with Warm Beige. Accent ears,
above eyes & on muzzle with White. Blush cheeks, inside ears
& lower lip with Dusty Rose. #4. Drybrush antlers Cocoa
Brown; highlight with Toffee. #5. Drybrush hat Barn Red; work

a little White into brush & highlight. #6. Drybrush wreath Forest Green; highlight with Clover Green. To create "holly berries" apply Scarlet Red dots to form triangles. #7. Wetbrush fur White. #8. Paint eyes White. Irises are Cocoa Brown with a Pumpkin slash. Pupils, lashes, eyebrows, nose & mouthline are Black. #9. Apply Diamond Dust to tips of antiers & top of hat & ears to simulate snow. CHIMNEY: #1. Basecoat with Light Grey. #2. Drybrush bricks Barn Red; highlight with Smoke. #3. Apply Black & Forest Green in a random pattern.

above eyes & ear edge with White. Blush cheeks, forehead &
inside of ear with Dusty Rose, #4. Wetbrush suit & hat with
Barn Red; Work a little White into brush & highlight, #5.
Drybrush scarl & mittens Forest Green; highlight with Clover
Green. Stripes on scarl are White & Metallic Gold. V stitches
on mittens are White, #6. Drybrush fur trim White. #7. Paint
candy cane White, Paint Barn Red on alternating stripes.
Apply Glossy Sealer to candy cane, #8. Paint eves White. candy cane White. Paint Barn Hed on alternating stripes. Apply Glossy Sealer to candy cane. #8. Paint eyes White. Irises are Burnt Brown with a Pumpkin slash. Pupils, nose, eyebrows & mouthlines are Black. #9. Paint tongue Dusty Rose. #10. Apply Diamond Dust to top of hat & ear to simulate snow. Drybrush fur trim White. #6 Paint eyes White. Irises are Cocoa Brown with Pumpkin slash. Pupils, noses & mouthlines are Black. #7. Paint holly leaves Forest Green; highlight with Clover Green. Hollyberries are Barn Red. #8. Paint bows Metallic Gold.

use Antiquing Solvent only on Santa & water. #3. Wetbrush
Santa's skin Gentle Flesh; work a little White into brush &
highlight. Blush cheeks, back of head, lip, nose, soles of feet &
on body near water line with Dusty Rose. #4. Drybrush Santa's
hair White. #5. Wetbrush water & bubbles Medium Blue.
Wetbrush bubbles heavily with White. #6. Apply two coats of
Glossy Sealer to water & bubbles; work a little Glossy Sealer
up Santa's body from water so that he looks wet. Apply Brush
on Glitter randomly on bubbles. #7. Wetbrush deer Toffee;
highlight with Warm Beige, Accent with White around eyes, sar
edges & jaw line. Blush cheeks & inside of ears with Dusty
Rose. #8. Drybrush antlers Cocca Brown; highlight Toffee. #9.
Paint all eyes White. Deer's irises are Cocca Brown with
rungkin slash. Santa's irises are Medium Blue. All pupils are
Black. #10. Paint deer noses area and of arms Black. Paint
tongue Barn Red. #11. Apply Glossy Sealer to all eyes &
deer's tongue. HOT TUB: #1. Basecoat tub with Barn Red.
Paint sign Medium Blue. #2. Antique with Shimmering Bark.
Don't use solvent. #3. Wetbrush tub Barn Red. Work. Light
Grey Into brush & highlight. #4. Wetbrush sign Medium Blue.
Howeld in the brush wetgels wetgels are forest Green.

& nails on sign are Metallic Gold. Sign letters are Barn Red.
#7. Drybrush childrens' pants Country Blue. #8. Childrens'
jackets & hats are drybrushes & highlighted White. Fur trim is
drybrushed White. #9. Paint boots & dog Black. Drybrush with
Smoke. Dog's collar is Scarlet Red. #10. Childrens' scarves
are Medium Yellow drybrushed with White. Mittens & ear muffs
are Clover Green, #11. Apply Diarmond Dust to snow & icicles.

nose, lip & back of head with Dusty Rose. #4. Wetbrush hair &
fur heavily with White. #5. Wetbrush suit Barn Red; work a little
White into brush & highlight. #6. Wetbrush hair &
fur heavily with White. #5. Wetbrush deer Toffee,
highlight with Warm Beige. Accent with White on muzzle,
around eyes & ear edges. Blush cheeks & inside ears Dusty
Rose. #7. Drybrush artilers Cocca Brown; highlight Toffee, #8.
Paint Black on boots, belt & deers hooves & noses. #9. Paint
gloves Forest Green; drybrush Clover Green. #10. Paint eyes
White. Deer irises are Cocca Brown with Pumpkin slash.
Santa has Medium Blue Irises. Pupils are Black with White
highlight dot. #11. Paint windows of lanterns Medium Yellow.
Paint rest of lantern Metallic Gold. Apply Brush on Glitter to
lantern windows.
