

"SPRING HOP" TL DESIGNS - FLYTL21 - 4/99

PIGGY POTS & SWINGER

TL722 2 Piggy Pots, 3.5" tall TL723 Medium Piggy Pot, 5.25" tall TL724 Large Piggy Pot, 7.25" tall TL727 Swinging Piggy, 5.5" tall

OPAQUE STAINS
CO108 Walnut CO110 Flesh
CO112 Terra Cotta CO116 Dark Blond
CO137 Peach Blush CO140 Burgundy
CO153 Sage Green CO156 Dark Flesh

While the swinger is in wet greenware, poke holes through his hands and in the swing (evenly spaced in the board). Fire 05.

For pots, on 04 bisque, glaze inside with Duncan's SN363 Terra Cotta. Fire 06.

BC body and face with thinned Dark Flesh. BC remainder of pot with Terra Cotta, thinning and washing over face and body. Float Sage Green widely over top edge of pot and under rim. Disperse with some water so entire pot is covered. You may need to add more green to the center of the pot. Wash Sage Green over body and face lightly.

DB face and body with Dark Flesh. HL with Flesh. Blush

cheeks, nose and belly with Peach Blush.

DB with Terra Cotta where needed on the pot (to show up

cracks and remove any drips).

Mix a very small amount of Burgundy with Peach Blush. Thin and apply to hooves. Eyes are Walnut.

Paint swing Dark Blond.

FROG POT HOPPERS

TL729 Medium Frog Pot Hopper, 5" tall TL730 Small Frog Pot Hoppers, 4" tall TL731 Large Frog Pot Hopper, 8.5" tall **

OPAQUE STAINS
CO104 Black CO112 Terra Cotta
CO113 Autumn Rust CO117 Sunflower
CO119 Bright Orange CO120 Parrot Green
CO124 Sherwood Green CO155 French Vanilla

Thin all basecoat colors. BC breast with French Vanilla. Mix Parrot Green with Sherwood Green 1:1 and brush on face and legs of frog. Thin more and brush over breast area. Brush remainder of pot with Terra Cotta, thinning but not leaving the pot streaky. Thin paint more and brush over green frog. Add water to disperse if it is too solid looking. Use the green BC color from the frog and swipe around top edge of pot and under rim and here and there on pot. Disperse with water so there are no hard edges. DB frog with Parrot Green. HL with Sunflower in brush. DB pot with Terra Cotta to accent cracks and clean up any drip marks. Eyes are first painted with Bright Orange, then floated with Autumn Rust. Pupil is Black.

KING FROG & FROG ON SWING

TL732 King Frog, 8" tall ** TL733 Swinging Frog, 4.5" tall

OPAQUE STAINS	CO101 White
CO104 Black	CO113 Autumn Rust
CO117 Sunflower	CO119 Bright Orange
CO120 Parrot Green	CO124 Sherwood Green
CO130 Electric Blue	CO135 Soft Pink
CO151 Marigold Yellow	CO155 French Vanilla

While the frog on the swing is in wet greenware, poke holes through his hands and in the swing (a little towards the back for levelness). Fire 05.

As an option, while the "King is in wet greenware, you can cut the crown of the "King" so it fits between the eyes. Cut a hole large enough to fit a candlecup in the center so it can be lit up!

Fire greenware to 05.

Thin all basecoat colors. Paint breast with thinned French Vanilla. Paint rest of frog with Parrot Green. Wash over breast with very thin Parrot Green. DB frog's body with Parrot Green and Sunflower. Continue to add more Sunflower to brush, always having some green in it. HL by adding White to brush.

Float body with a mix of Sherwood Green and Black. Paint cup Bright Orange and crown with Marigold Yellow. Paint pipe with Electric Blue lightened with White. Eyes are Bright Orange floated with Autumn Rust and the pupil is Black.

Paint the swing Soft Pink.

SUN BIRD FEEDER

TL728 Sun Birdfeeder, 10" dia. **

OPAQUE STAINS	CO101 White
CO115 Country Gold	CO117 Sunflower
CO119 Bright Orange	CO130 Electric Blue

Thin Sunflower and paint entire piece. Wash thinned Bright Orange into the detail area of the rays. DB with Sunflower and White in the brush. HL with more White on high points of the face.

Float Country Gold around the sun and into detail of his face, especially under lower lip. Eyes are Electric Blue lightened with White.

WORKER GNOME

TL725 Worker Gnome Pot, 16" tall **

CO101 White CO104 Black CO109 Deep Brown CO112 Terra Cotta CO115 Country Gold CO130 Electric Blue
JOI 10 COULT TO LICCUITO DIAC
CO143 Confederate Grey CO144 Medium Bro
CO153 Sage Green CO156 Dark Flesh

Thin all basecoat colors.

Thin Dark Flesh and paint to skin areas. Paint Confederate Gray to the beard and brows, Terra Cotta to the pot, Country Gold to the shirt, Deep Brown to the pants and Black to the shoes. Wash Sage Green over the pot, letting it spill onto clothing and shoes and dispersing with more water.

Wash Deep Brown over the skin and hair areas. DB skin with Dark Flesh and beard and brows with Pale Gray. DB Terra Cotta over the pot to blend and to smooth the Sage Green antique. The wash should take care of the shadows on the clothing, but you may choose to DB the corresponding colors.

Paint hammer head with Water Base Silver and the handle with Medium Brown. Paint eyes Electric Blue lightened with White.

Thin all basecoat colors.

BC skin with Dark Flesh. BC beard with Shadow Gray mixed with Woodland Brown. BC the hat and jacket with Victorian Green darkened with Black Forest Green. BC pants with Deep Brown. Wash skin and beard with a Deep Brown wash. DB skin with Dark Flesh. Blush cheeks with Terra Cotta in the Dark Flesh brush. Thin Terra Cotta and paint lips. DB beard with Pale Gray and Warm Beige in the brush. DB the hat and jacket with Irish Green. HL last coat with Dark Blond in the brush.

DB pants with Medium Brown. BC shoes with Black and HL with some Warm Beige in the brush. Thin Black and paint rope belt. Paint Metallic Gold on the buttons. The eyes are Electric Blue lightened with White.

The birds shown are artificial. Check your local craft store!

BC=Basecoat DB=Drybrush HL=Highlight
