

## "GONE FISHIN" FLYTL30 - 9/00

## CROC POTS

TL857 LG CROC POT, 10.75" TALL \*\* TL858 MEDIUM CROC POT, 7" TALL TL859 2 SM CROC POTS, 4.5" TALL

On 04 bisque, glaze inside of pot if using for a real plant. Fire 06.

Thin Sunflower with water and apply to underside of mouth and chest and tail. Apply

thinned White to ridges on tail.

Mix Parrot and Irish Green 1:1 and thin slightly with water. Apply to body of alligator. Thin mix so it is transparent and wash over yellow and white areas.

Paint pot area with slightly thinned Terra Cotta.

Wash entire pot and croc with Black thinned with water so it is the consistency of water.

DB green area with the mix and Sunflower in brush. Add White in brush to highlight. Add more White to brush and brush on ridges along

DB yellow areas with Sunflower and a little White in the brush.

Thin the green mix and wash over Terra Cotta pot. This should not need to be drybrushed.

Paint teeth with thinned White. Paint nails with Black, eyes with White and pupils with Christmas Red and Black. Float Black around the mouth line.

Apply Gloss Sealer to eyes and nails.

FISH PLANTER/FISH BELL

LG FISH POT, 12" LONG \*\* TL865 MEDIUM FISH POT, 10" LONG TL866 TL867 SMALL FISH POT, 6" LONG TL868 2 TINY FISH POTS, 3" TALL FISH WINDCHIME, 12" LONG\*\* TL869

Thin all basecoat colors. BC teeth with White and tongue with Peach Blush. BC face and edges of all fins (1" into the fin) with Celery Green. Wash tongue with thinned Christmas Red. Wash face with Parrot Green and continue past the face onto the body about 2" unevenly. Do the same with the fins.

The next color is Teal Green. Wash over the Parrot Green areas and Celery Green areas very thin. Use less water and paint remainder of the fish. Thin Terra Cotta slightly and sporadically paint the pot. Thin Teal Green and wash over bisque areas left on the pot, washing

the color over the Terra Cotta Color.

DB fish face with Celery Green with a little Sunflower in the brush. Add more Sunflower and DB body of fish. Add more White to HL the face and tail fins. DB body of fish with Mint Green. If there is a need for contrast, float Teal Green to separate the fins and around the detail of the eyes and mouth.

DB Terra Cotta on the terra cotta sections of the pot and on the Teal Green areas. DB with Celery Green and Teal Green in the brush.

The eyes are Electric Blue lightened with

For the *fish bell or windchime*, glaze inside of bisque with CN302 Bright Caribbean. Fire 06.

Place hole in top for nylon cording and 2 holes in tail. Using smaller cording or wire, loop through the 2 holes in tail. Pull cording through top hole with wire. Tie knot under bell inside to desired length. Draw cording through loop created in the tail and tie securely.

FROG STAKE TL870 FROG STAKE, 19" TALL \*\*

Thin French Vanilla and BC breast. Thin Parrot Green and BC frog. Wash entire frog with a mix of Irish Green and Victorian Green 1:1 thinned like water.

DB green area with Parrot Green with Sunflower and a little White in brush. DB breast with Dark Blond and White in the brush.

Float frogs' deep detail with Irish Green mixed with Black. The eyes are painted with White. The iris is Bright Orange. The pupil is Black.

FRUITFLY TL863 MR. FRUITFLY, 6" TALL

Thin basecoat colors. Apply White to wings and Electric Blue to rest of bug (except antenna). Wash bug with very thin Black. DB wings White. DB body of bug with Electric Blue. Add a little White to brush and DB. Add Parrot Green to brush and HL. DB breast with Irish Green. HL with Sunflower. Paint claws and toenails with Black. Paint antenna Irish Green and balls on antenna with Black.

Float Black into deep crevices and to separate wings. Paint eyes with Bright Orange and pupils with Black. Apply Gloss Sealer to claws, toenails, eyes and wings.

PRAYING MANTIS TL871 PRAYING MANTIS, 5.5" TALL

Thin Parrot Green and BC body of bug. BC wings White.

Thin Black even more and wash over bug.

DB body with Parrot Green. Add Sunflower to brush and DB second coat. HL with more Sunflower in brush. Add White to HL. DB wings with White.

Paint antenna Black. DB Electric Blue. Paint balls of antenna with Bright Orange.

Paint eyes with Christmas Red and mix Bright Orange with the red at base of eye. Paint pupils with Black.

Float Black into deep crevices. Apply Gloss Sealer to eyes.

ANT

TL860 MR. ANT, 5.5" TALL

BC teeth with White. BC body with slightly thinned Autumn Rust. Thin Black like water and brush over ant. DB ant with a mix of Bright Orange and Medium Brown 1:1.

Re-paint teeth with White using a small brush. Paint antlers with Black and tip on antler with Water Base Copper.

Thin 1 part Water Base Copper with 3 parts water and brush over ant. DB hands and cheeks with Water Base Copper.

Eyes are Electric Blue lightened with White.

CATERPILLAR TL872 CATERPILLAR, 4" LONG

BC with a mix of Electric Blue and Burgundy

so it is a deep purple color.

DB and stipple with Periwinkle. Add Soft Pink to the brush and lighten the top of bug and around face. Dot the top of area of bug with Soft Pink. Use the end of a brush handle for

Paint the antlers with Parrot Green with Black on the ball ends. Eyes are Electric Blue lightened with White.

Use a thin liner and line Black to separate bug's body. Spatter body with White, using a tooth brush or any stiff brush.

BUTTERFLY

TL864 BUTTERFLY, 5.75" TALL

Paint the body with Celery Green. Paint the wings with a mix of Hot Pink and Soft Pink 1:1.

Thin Teal Green like water and brush over the body. DB the body with Mint Green. Add White to brush to HL.

Using a fan brush, stroke Soft Purple on the middle area of the wings, brushing toward the inner area. Brush Turquoise in the same manner, only lower and overlapping some of the purple.

Airbrush or DB White on the edges of the wings. Airbrush White on the belly and cheeks

of the body of the butterfly.

Paint spots on the wings with Mint Green. Darken one end of the spot with Teal Green, fading into the Mint Green by adding Mint Green to the Teal Green and stippling them together on the spot.

Dot with White on the lighter area of the spot

and eyelids. Spatter White on wings.

Paint antlers with the lower ring being Black and the rest with Teal Green. Paint the balls on the ends with Mint Green.

The eyes are Teal Green lightened with Mint

LADYBUG

TL861 MRS. LADYBUG, 5.5" TALL

Paint the breast and face with slightly thinned Dark Blond. Paint the shell with Christmas Red solidly. Paint the head with Black. (Refer to picture.) Thin Black like water and wash over entire bug. DB yellow areas with Dark Blond. Brush over the red shell with a square shader using Christmas Red and Bright Orange in the brush. Paint the spots of shell and arms with Black. HL hands by drybrushing Black with a very little White in the brush.

Float Black around the chest where it meets the shell.

Eyes are Electric Blue lightened with White. Apply Gloss Sealer to the shell and antlers.

BUMBLEBEE

TL862 MR. BUMBLEBEE, 5.25" TALL

Thin White for the wings. BC the yellow areas with Sunflower and the black areas with Black. (Refer to picture.)

Thin Black so it is like water and wash over bee. DB wings with White. DB yellow areas with Sunflower with a little White in the brush. For the black areas, HL only with Black and a little White in the brush.

Paint nose and feet with Black. Eyes are Electric Blue lightened with White.

LARGE FISH ICE BUCKET TL865 LARGE FISH POT, 12" LONG \*\*

On 04 bisque, brush thinned CN201 Light Grey over the teeth. Remove excess to antique. Brush thinned CN302 Bright Caribbean over the fish except for the lower half of the tail, side fins and belly of fish. Brush over the top of the fin on the body. Remove excess using the flat side of a glaze brush. Thin CN272 Bright Jade and wash over the remaining bisque, removing excess.

Brush 2 coats of CN271 Light Jade over face and wherever the fish was antiqued with Bright Jade. Brush 2 coats of Light Bluespruce over the body of fish antiqued with the Bright Caribbean. Overlapping color is good. When brushing on these colors, skip over the detail in the fish so as not to lighten.

For the pot, thin CN053 Dark Tangerine and brush flowingly and sporadically over the pot. Hold the fish upside down so as not to drip any color on the fish. Fill in the bisque areas on the pot with thinned CN302 Bright Caribbean. Overlapping is fine.

Thin Bright Caribbean slightly using a fan brush and brush the inside of the pot in a circular direction.

The eyes are 2 coats of CN121 Light Nautical. The pupils are CN253 Dark Black. Outline the eyes in Dark Black.

Dip or brush on Clear Glaze. Fire 06.

Use National Artcraft's #361-002-07 porthole for top. Epoxy on.
